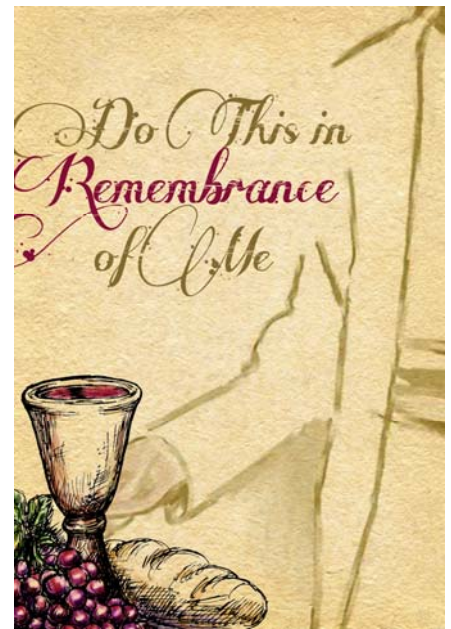

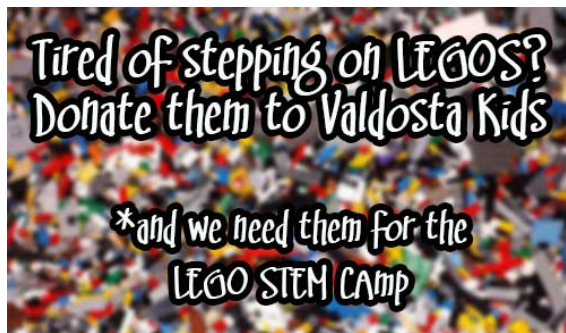
Pastor's Picks Book Study/Discussion-DATE CHANGE

Taught by Rev. Benny Olliff and meets in the Adult Building Room 102.

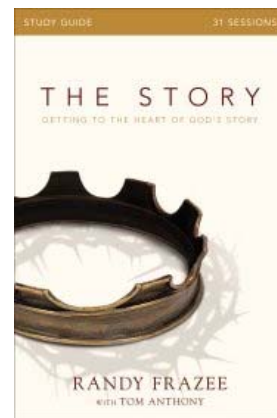
"The Story, Getting to the Heart of God's Story"
