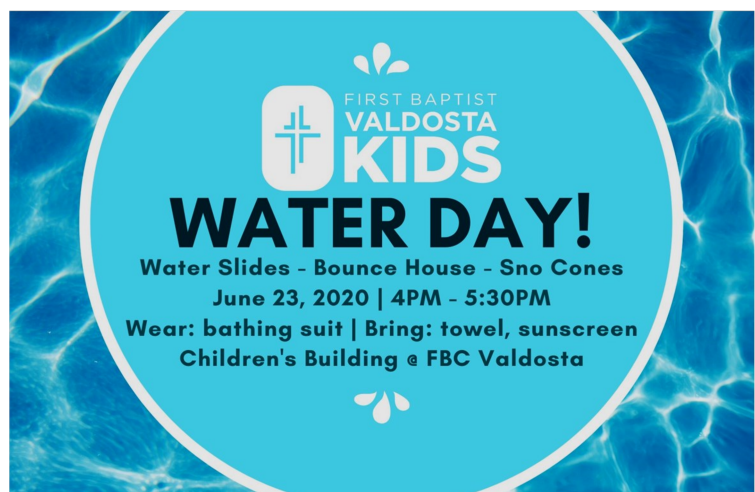

Dear Church Family,

I received an e-mail message from Pastor Soonthorn at the House of Blessing Ministry and Prison Ministry in Bangkok, Thailand. Due to the Coronavirus the Prison Ministry House of Blessing teams have not been able to go into prisons to share the Gospel for the past four months. However, they have been sending Christian Messages of the Gospel and personal testimonies into the prisons by video.

The House of Blessing provides a Bible and a Bible Correspondence Course for those who accept Christ through this ministry. In the past four months, over 300 prisoners have accepted Christ and Pastor Soonthorn has requested that our church provide 300 Bibles for those who have accepted Christ. Hopefully, our team can baptize many of these new Christians in January 2021. The cost of one Bible is \$15.00 and the 300 Bibles would cost \$4,500.
