This past Thursday, July 23, the City of Valdosta Historical Preservation Commission presented 2020 Valdosta Preservation Award to First Baptist Church of Valdosta. The Stewardship award, which was presented to Mac Weaver at the City Council Meeting, represents 120 years of First Baptist maintaining a beautiful campus and the awareness of the historical significance of First Baptist to the downtown historical district.

First Baptist Church has represented the Gospel of Jesus Christ to this community for these 120 years and the First Baptist Sanctuary is one of the most beautiful sanctuaries anywhere. The most recent renovation that brought our attention to the Historical Preservation Commission was the renovation of the Langdale Chapel.
