

## **Music Ministry**

Recently I shared nine propositions for worship with our choir and praise band that should inform our service and direct us continually back to our vision and mission: to love God, love other, and love the world AND we exist to help every person to know and follow Jesus.

Here is the first proposition.

Christian worship should be biblical. The Bible is the source of our knowledge of God and of the world's redemption in Christ. Worship should include abundant readings of scriptures. It should present and depict God's being, character, and actions in ways that are consistent with scriptural teaching. It should obey explicit biblical commands about worship practices, and it should heed scriptural warnings about false and improper worship. Worship should focus its primary attention where the Bible does: on the person and work of Jesus Christ as Redeemer of all creation and the founder and harbinger of the kingdom of God through the work of the Holy Spirit.
