Robert Lowry (1826-1899) was a popular Baptist pastor in various churches throughout the eastern US. In later life he became interested in writing and publishing gospel songs. Today he's best remembered for his many contributions to our hymnal with songs such as "Nothing but the Blood," published in 1876. Though simply stated both textually and musically, this gospel song has had an important place in the church's ministry in teaching both young and old, the absolute necessity of trusting implicitly in the precious blood of Christ for this life and for eternity.
