And many scriptures and lyrics of songs immediately permeate my thoughts. The Psalmist wrote a prayer to God asking Him to "teach us to number our days carefully so that we may develop wisdom in our hearts" (Psalm 90:12).

The poet Jennie Wilson, author of the classic hymn, "Hold to God's Unchanging Hand," (1904) penned:
