Several years ago, I encountered a new Advent hymn from "Lift Up Your Hearts" (Faith Alive Christian Resources - 2013) in which Richard Leach addresses the angel's Announcement to the Virgin Mary, her reaction, and the subsequent changes.

"Told of God's favor, told of God's purpose,

Mary said 'Tell me, how can this be?'

Told of the spirit, told of the power, told of the promise, Mary said yes."

Verse 2

"Yes, to conceiving, yes, to the body changing and growing, yes to the flesh – yes, to the new life kicking within her, yes to the pleasure, yes to the pain."

Later the hymn asks us a question.

Verse 4

"Told of Christ Jesus, told of the Spirit, can we say yes as Mary said yes? Yes, for our bodies, yes for our spirits, yes for the future, yes for right now."

I am reminded of the cost of discipleship in the life of a believer. God not only calls us to love him with all of our heart and soul and mind, but with all of our strength, that is, with our bodies. Will we say yes to the daily physical challenges for the glory of God and for the purposes of the Gospel?
