Already decked in my white dress shirt and dress pants, I attempted to clean out the culprit and get that casserole started. About midway into that cleaning process, I thought, "Oh no! I hope my clothes don't smell like smoke for services today!" Though I didn't detect it on me, I was still thinking of that as we were leaving for church. Smell like smoke. Hmm. Maybe we should, according to the scriptures. Jude verse 23 says, "Save others by snatching them from the fire" (CSB). Having that close relationship to be able to speak life and truth will certainly have its effects. Jesus was accused of being the friends of sinners (Luke 8:34).
